

- Mr. Jebens described the OIP process with the BOE so that they have an understanding of the team based structure (TBT, BLT and DLT) and the communication between these forums
- Mr. Comer explained how the BLT is utilizing the OTGP Risk Calculator to better meet the needs of our students in the areas of attendance, behavior, academics and engagement
- Dr. Burts-Beatty reported to the DLT the SST role within the OTGP and the communication that takes place between her office and the ODE offices in Columbus about challenges and pain points – specifically human capital issues / turnover and the walking district vs. bussing districts
- Mr. Longworth shared the Equity Access Plan within the CCIP (due by 3/1/19) was shared / discussed with the DLT in its deadline draft form

- Mr. Longworth shared the Winter 2019 K-12 Literacy Data Analysis from the MTSS Universal Screener Benchmark Assessment Comparison (Fall to Winter) was shared with the group. Trends and patterns were identified within the data by skill area / grade band for the purpose of evaluating the effectiveness of the K-12 Local Literacy plan effect in each grade level, to determine future PD needs and areas of growth and continued focus
- Mr. Longworth shared the Winter 2019 PBIS Data Analysis report comparing the 2017-18 and 2018-19 school years from the first day of school through 2/25 both years.
  - Trends and patterns were identified within the data by consequence, most frequent infractions, offense location, offense by grade level, reports by ethnicity and by IEP / LEP subgroup for the purpose of evaluating the effectiveness of the K-12 PBIS framework in each grade level, to determine future PD needs and areas of growth and continued focus for improvement.
  - Dr. Burts-Beatty shared the SPP implications with the state as it relates to discipline data and SWD. Dr. Burts-Beatty discussed the importance of Functional Behavior Assessments (FBA), Behavior Improvement Plans (BIP) and intense PD needs with behavior interventions and social emotional learning (SEL) topics
  - Dr. Burts-Beatty discussed the importance of systemic implementation of PBIS in grades K-12
  - o Open discussion about the trends and patterns
  - Discussion about targeted PD planning for the next school year based on trends in data and a scaffolded approach determined by need
  - Discussion about coaching models and on-going and job-embedded PD models and potential grant funding
