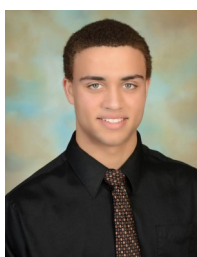

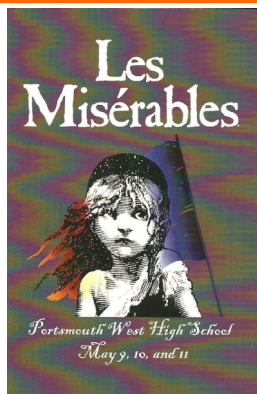

Head Preschool teachers, Marcy Augustin and Abbey Cox, are highly qualified professionals with bachelor's degrees in the field of early childhood education. These teachers work in close collaboration with

Lindsay Mitchell, Head Start teacher.

Preschool children must be either 3 or 4 years of age by September 30 and must be potty trained. Washington-Nile Schools provides transportation to/from children's homes to PWES on the elementary bus routes/times. Breakfast, lunch and a snack are provided as well. Preschool is scheduled for Monday-Thursday each week.

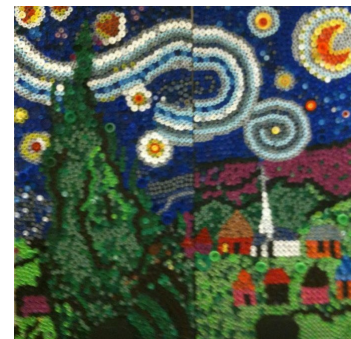
