A student who is initiated into the National Junior Honor Society **will be dismissed** from the Honor Society if any of the following occur:

1. A member receives two detentions, two in-school suspensions, or is suspended out of school during the school year.
2. A member receives a F in any subject.
3. A member is placed on academic probation for more than one grading period. Academic probation occurs when the student's grade point average falls below 3.40 for any grading period.
4. A member violates any of the school rules or displays citizenship or conduct which is not in keeping with the standards of the National Junior Honor Society such as cheating, disrespect to persons in authority, etc.. This is up to the discretion of the advisors and administrators.

A student who has been initiated into the National Junior Honor Society and has been dismissed for any reason, academic or disciplinary, will return his or her membership certificate to the advisor immediately.

I understand that completion of this form does not guarantee membership, but that I am being considered for membership in the Magnus Meritus Chapter of the National Junior Honor Society. I also understand that all five components should be met. I will accept the decision of the faculty committee charged with the responsibility of selecting members as final.

If I am elected to membership, I agree to participate in National Junior Honor Society activities and to abide by the scholarship, leadership, character, service, and citizenship standards of the National Junior Honor Society (NJHS). My signature indicates I accept the role of active membership which includes attendance at meetings and volunteering my time for other NJHS programs and activities.
