3 years of Science (Biology/lab required)

3 years of Mathematics

1 year of a World Language

Phys. Ed. / Health for every year enrolled in NJ public school

1 year of Visual OR Performing Arts

1 year of Career/Life Skills/Vocational Education

1 Semester (1/2 year) Personal Financial Literacy

### **College Entrance Requirements**

4 years of English

3 years of College Prep Math

(Algebra 1, Geometry, Algebra 2)

Higher math is required for majors in:

Engineering, Science, Architecture and Business

3 years of Lab Science

2 years of the same World Language

2-4 years of History/Social Studies

NOTE: The most competitive colleges expect you to take up to 4 years from each core subject area regardless of intended major!
