All Fair Lawn School buildings will be closed until January 15 and we will return to our hybrid schedule on Tuesday, January 19 (please note that schools are closed on Monday, January 18 to observe Martin Luther King Jr. Day.). That said, if your child becomes symptomatic or someone if your family tests positive for COVID-19, please contact your child's school nurse, even when the building is closed. Our teachers have done an amazing job planning and preparing for just this occasion, and the students are now more comfortable following all-remote schedules.
