2. <u>2016-2017 Budget Overview</u>

Mr. Watson presented an overview of the 2016-2017 budget. Highlights were as follows:

- Total Budget \$95,662,787
- State Aid, Debt Service Aid & Retables are not yet available
- Allowable: 2% tax growth of \$1,590,397
 \$721,060 in weighted enrollment & health benefits.
- Total allowable tax growth is \$2,359,704
- General Fund increases 2.91%
- Debt Service increases 3.03%
- Appropriating from surplus
 - \$1,500,000 to reduce general fund taxes
 - \$609,923 to reduce debt service taxes

Monthly cost on average assessed home of \$325,322 is \$14.92/mo. 2.91% tax growth
