The 2020/2021 Tax Increase

- ▶ Our State Aid has increased by \$1,825,829
- Property values (ratables) updated:
 - ▶ The average Fair Lawn assessed home is now valued at \$332,371
- ▶ State DOE budget software indicates our district is entitled to:
 - ▶ A weighted enrollment adjustment of \$1,158,640
- ▶ Our total allowable tax increase to \$1,844,193
- ▶ Our total <u>actual</u> tax increase is \$1,737,759

The cost increase for the average assessed value home is \$13.44 monthly / \$161.28 annually

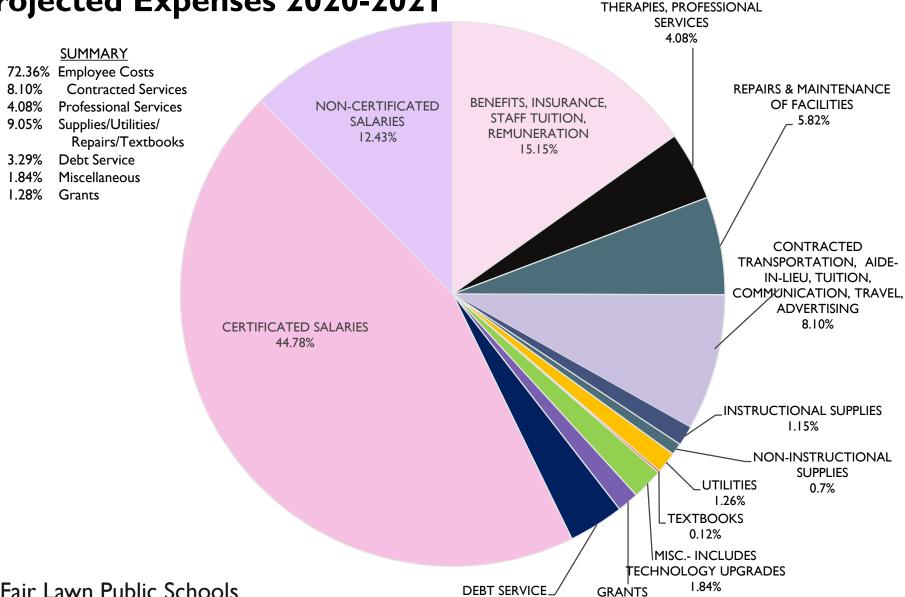
