#### Approval of Merit Goals for Business Administrator, Brooke Bartley

**WHEREAS**, the Fair Lawn Board of Education submitted merit pay criteria for the 2019-2020 school year for Ms. Brooke Bartley to the Bergen County Interim Executive Superintendent for review on September 27, 2019.

**WHEREAS**, the Bergen County Interim Executive Superintendent approved the merit pay criteria for Ms. Brooke Bartley on October 18, 2019.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the Board hereby certifies that the following qualitative and quantitative criteria that was submitted and approved by the Bergen County Interim Executive Superintendent have been satisfactorily completed by Ms. Bartley:

#### **Quantitative**

- 1. The Business Administrator will establish one maintenance reserve account with a deposit of \$50,000 in line with fiscally responsible planning and thereby reducing budgetary impact for future years. Value: 3.33% of base salary = \$5,678.32
- 2. The Business Administrator will increase 2019-2020 investment earnings 50% above investment earnings per the 2017-2018 financial statements in Exhibit A-2. Value: 3.33% of base salary = \$5,678.32
- 3. The Business Administrator will enhance food service at elementary schools by developing a plan for renovation of the food service preparation areas and serving lines at one elementary school. To change the current operation of the food service from a satellite method to portable bulk serving lines. This will require the renovation of existing space: additional sinks, refrigeration, HVAC, and retraining of staff for new method of serving and to maintain compliance with federal meal reimbursements. Value: 3.33% of base salary = \$5,678.32

#### Qualitative

1. The Business Administrator will oversee the \$25 million referendum construction project in three different locations. HVAC project at Fair Lawn High School, additions and renovations at both Thomas Jefferson and Memorial Middle Schools. Value: 2.5% of base salary = \$4,263.00.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that Ms. Bartley is entitled to, and shall receive, a merit pay bonus of \$21,297.96 which is equal to 12.49% of her base salary of \$170,520; **AND** 

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED,** that the Board shall submit the resolution to the Bergen County Interim Executive Superintendent for review and approval prior to payment being made to Ms. Bartley.
