During the Public Comment portion of the meeting, Allen Flowers addressed the board about the Purple Tie Club sponsored by Omega Psi Phi and the possibility of implementing one in the district.

Dyslexia Coordinator Karen Ivers and the Dyslexia staff gave a presentation about the program.

The 2020-2021 audit report was reviewed by the board.

SWARK President Jimmy Hawley, Vice President Mark Ross and General Manager Bren Yocom addressed the board about the partnership they would like to form with Hope Public Schools through Bobcat Works for media coverage of activities and events happening within the district, as well as livestream coverage of Bobcat Football and Basketball games.

On a motion by Viney Johnson with a second by Margaret Moss, the board voted to approve the 22-23 student handbooks for Beryl Henry, Hope Academy of Public Service and Hope High School. Motion carried 7-0.

Classified Personnel Policy Committee Chairman Alvin Hunter addressed the board with the proposed changes from that committee. On a motion by Margaret Moss with a second by Kathryn Dickinson, the board voted to approve the policy updates minus the typos or index/stipend changes as presented by the Classified Personnel Policy Committee. Motion carried 7-0.

A closed executive session was held.

The meeting was reconvened. On a motion by David Powers with a second by Alvis Hamilton, the board voted to approve Items 1, 2, 3, and 4 and to hold Item 5 for abeyance. Motion carried 7-0.
