Dyslexia Program 2021-2022

During the 2021-2022 school year, Hazen Public School District used the following evidence based reading programs depending on the needs of the students:

Intervention was provided using The Barton Reading and Spelling Program in a one-on-one/small group setting to address the deficit areas of students identified as exhibiting the characteristics of dyslexia by a Certified Barton Tutor/Dyslexia Interventionist and trained interventionists. Barton Remote through the Whizzimo app was also provided.

Number of Students Who Received Dyslexia Intervention:

During the 2021-2022 school year, 51 students attending the Hazen Public School District received dyslexia intervention services from a Certified Barton Tutor/Dyslexia Interventionist and trained interventionists.

Total Number of Students Identified as Exhibiting the Characteristics of Dyslexia:

During the 2021-2022 school year, 68 students attending Hazen School District were identified as exhibiting the characteristics of dyslexia.
