**Dyslexia Program 2022-2023**

**During the 2022-2023 school year, Hazen Public School District used the following evidence based reading programs depending on the needs of the students:**

**Intervention was provided using The Barton Reading and Spelling Program in a one-on-one/small group setting to address the deficit areas of students identified as exhibiting the characteristics of dyslexia by a Certified Barton Tutor/Dyslexia Interventionist and trained interventionists. Exercises from the book Equipped for Reading Success by David A. Kilpatrick, Ph.D. were also utilized.**

**Number of Students Who Received Dyslexia Intervention:**

**During the 2022-2023 school year, 52 students attending the Hazen Public School District received dyslexia intervention services from a Certified Barton Tutor/Dyslexia Interventionist and trained interventionists.**

**Total Number of Students Identified as Exhibiting the Characteristics of Dyslexia:**

**During the 2022-2023 school year, 68 students attending Hazen School District were identified as exhibiting the characteristics of dyslexia.**
