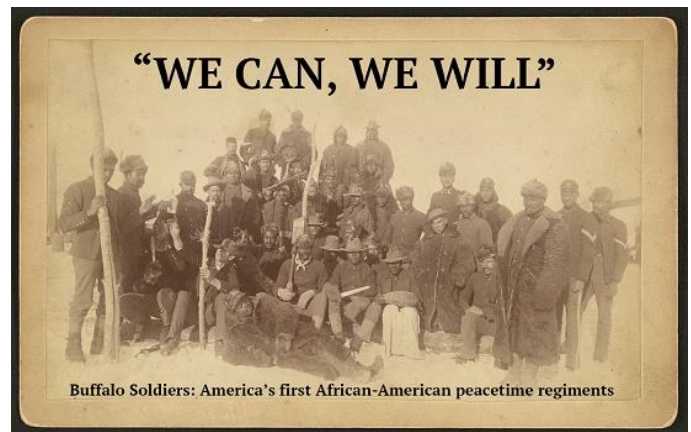

The Buffalo soldiers were six all black regiments established by Congress in 1866. Totaling 6, 000, the Buffalo soldiers helped rebuild the country after the Civil War and patrol the remote western frontier. The Buffalo soldiers were the explorers, park rangers, "Protectors of the West" and peace makers. The Buffalo soldiers provided heroic service within the military, which remained segregated until the US military finally became integrated in 1948.
