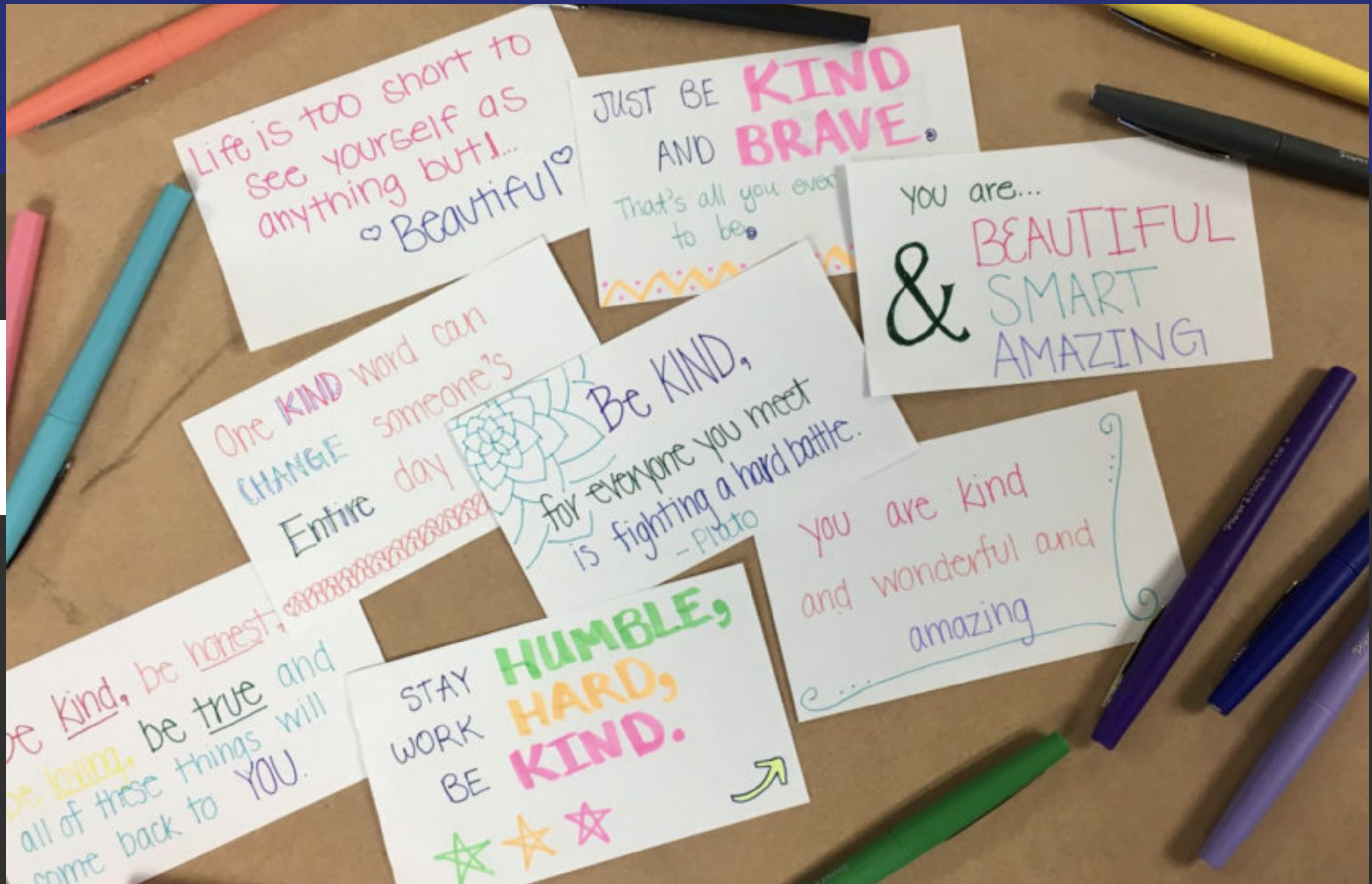

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Restroom Behavior

Cell Phone and Personal Telecommunications/Devices Policy

For safety and security purposes:

- restrooms at school or at a school-related or school-sponsored event.

Personal devices are not allowed out during school hours without permission (cell phones, ipads, etc.)



Cell Phone and Personal Telecommunications/Devices Policy

If a student uses a telecommunications device without authorization during the school day, the device will be confiscated.

- **First Time** - Device will be taken to the office and students may pick it up in the office after school.
- **Second Time** - Student may pick it up and pay \$15.00.
- **Third Time** - \$15.00 and Parent must come and pick up the phone.

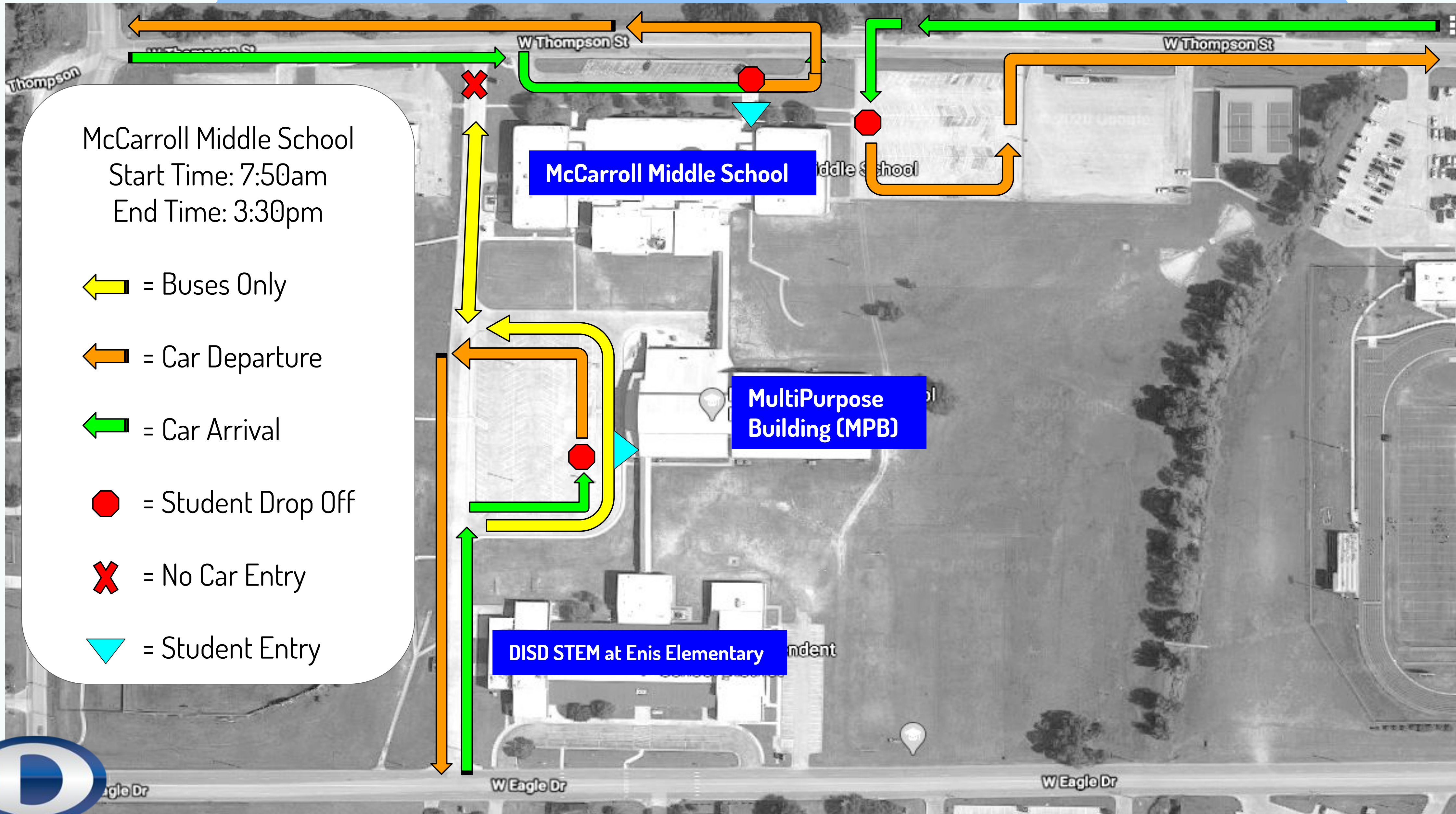

← = Car Arrival

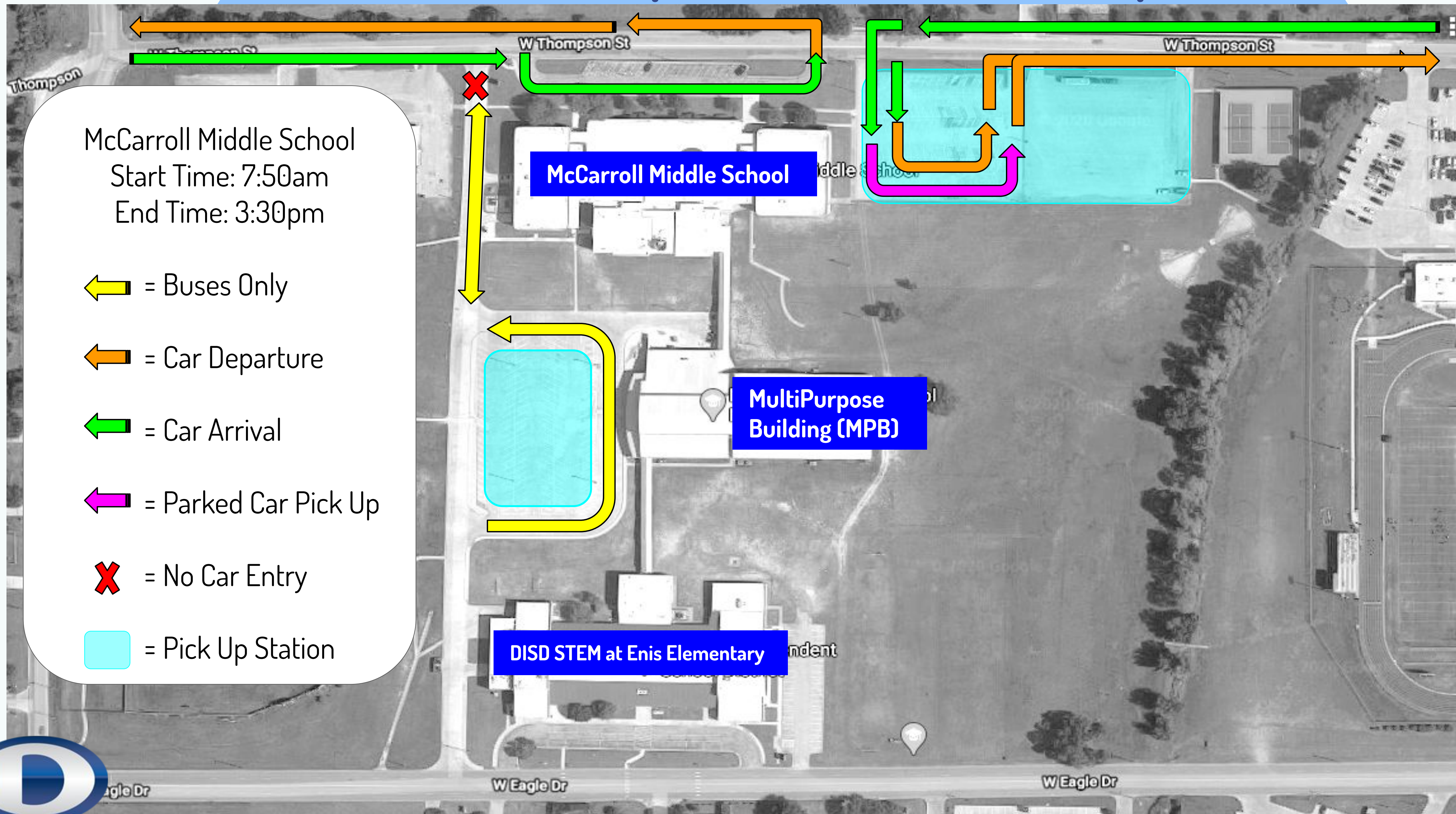

Before school - Where do students go before school.

- The doors open at 7:20am. Doors will not open earlier. Many doors are on timers and are locked.
- 6th graders come to the MPB before school.
- 7th and 8th in the Main Gym before school starts.



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Breakfast and Lunch for 22-23

- Per USDA, school breakfasts and lunches will be the traditional method of processing applications and cost based on eligibility.
- Students may purchase extra food or drinks if they have money in their account.



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Lunch time and Lunch Drop Off

6th grade lunch time is set for 10:55am-11:25am

Lunch Drop Off Procedure:

- Please make sure that your child knows ahead of time that you are bringing their lunch to school
- Parents may bring lunch into the front office
- Fill out the form with student name and grade



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Lunch Procedures

- Walk at all times.
- Enter the MPB Cafeteria and sit at tables. Six to a table.
- Students are excused to get their lunch by sections.
- At the Table:
 - Stay in your seat
 - No sharing of food.
 - If you make a mess, you will need to clean it up.
 - Check to be sure the table and floor area are clean before you leave.
- Lunch Dismissal
 - Table should be free of trash and food before students are dismissed.
 - Students are dismissed by sections.
 - Move quietly out of the MPB and orderly back to the main building.



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Safety

IN AN EMERGENCY TAKE ACTION



HOLD! In your room or area. Clear the halls.

STUDENTS

Clear the hallways and remain in room or area until the "All Clear" is announced
Do business as usual

ADULTS

Close and lock the door
Account for students and adults
Do business as usual



SECURE! Get inside. Lock outside doors.

STUDENTS

Return to inside of building
Do business as usual

ADULTS

Bring everyone indoors
Lock outside doors
Increase situational awareness
Account for students and adults
Do business as usual



LOCKDOWN! Locks, lights, out of sight.

STUDENTS

Move away from sight
Maintain silence
Do not open the door

ADULTS

Recover students from hallway if possible
Lock the classroom door
Turn out the lights
Move away from sight
Maintain silence
Do not open the door
Prepare to evade or defend



EVACUATE! (A location may be specified)

STUDENTS

Leave stuff behind if required to
If possible, bring your phone
Follow instructions

ADULTS

Lead students to Evacuation location
Account for students and adults
Notify if missing, extra or injured students or adults



SHELTER! Hazard and safety strategy.

STUDENTS

Use appropriate safety strategy for the hazard

Hazard

Tornado
Hazmat
Earthquake
Tsunami

Safety Strategy

Evacuate to shelter area
Seal the room
Drop, cover and hold
Get to high ground

ADULTS

Lead safety strategy
Account for students and adults
Notify if missing, extra or injured students or adults
