# Lunch Procedures

- Walk at all times.
- Enter the MPB Cafeteria and sit at tables. Six to a table.
- Students are excused to get their lunch by sections.
- At the Table:
  - $\rightarrow$  Stay in your seat
  - $\rightarrow$  No sharing of food.
  - $\rightarrow$  If you make a mess, you will need to clean it up.
- Lunch Dismissal
  - Table should be free of trash and food before students are dismissed. Students are dismissed by sections. Move quietly out of the MPB and orderly back to the main building.

 $\rightarrow$  Check to be sure the table and floor area are clean before you leave.





# Safety

### **IN AN EMERGENCY TAKE ACTION**



### HOLD! In your room or area. Clear the halls. STUDENTS

Clear the hallways and remain in room or area until the "All Clear" is announced Do business as usual

ADULTS Close and lock the door Account for students and adults Do business as usual



### SECURE! Get inside. Lock outside doors. STUDENTS

Return to inside of building Do business as usual

ADULTS Bring everyone indoors

Lock outside doors Increase situational awareness Account for students and adults Do business as usual



### LOCKDOWN! Locks, lights, out of sight. STUDENTS ADULTS

Move away from sight Maintain silence Do not open the door

### Recover students from hallway if possible Lock the classroom door Turn out the lights

Move away from sight Maintain silence Do not open the door Prepare to evade or defend



### **EVACUATE!** (A location may be specified) STUDENTS ADULTS

Leave stuff behind if required to If possible, bring your phone Follow instructions

Lead students to Evacuation location Account for students and adults Notify if missing, extra or injured students or adults

### SHELTER! Hazard and safety strategy. STUDENTS ADULTS

Use appropriate safety strategy for the hazard
