Position: Summer Camp Health Care Provider

Thunderhead Episcopal Center strives to provide a place where all people who encounter camp know that they are loved and welcomed. This starts with hospitality provided by all staff, counselors, and volunteers.

Position Purpose: The Summer Camp Health Care Provider's (HCP) purpose is to ensure that the counselors, campers, and guests are supported in their physical and mental health. Many campers may take daily medications or have other medical and mental health needs. The HCP will ensure campers receive medications at the correct times as well as provide compassionate care for any other concerns that arise.

Duties and Responsibilities: Health Care Provider (HCP) ensures the safety and health of all participants of Thunderhead programs. This includes supporting both staff and campers. The HCP is a resource to staff by: reviewing staff health forms, assisting with any medical situations as needed, and checking in about their physical, mental and social health. Additionally, the HCP partners with us in taking care of campers. The HCP reviews camper health forms before each session in collaboration with the on site leadership and notifies the staff of any pre-existing conditions that may affect the camper's behavior and/or interaction with others. They distribute all medication, provide treatment in the event of an injury or illness (campers and staff), and maintain oversight of the general health of the entire camp community. HCP will assist the on site staff in ensuring proper organization of first aid supplies and notifying the leadership staff when items are needed. HCP will work with camp leadership to ensure appropriate time off each week.

Minimum Qualifications:

- Active certification preferred.
- Experience administering prescribed and PRN medications.
- Willingness to provide appropriate and discrete care to all members of the TEC community, including those who identify as LGBTQ+.
- Desire to work in a faith-based setting.
- Ability to remain on site during the agreed upon working timeframes. We are open to discussing weekly, monthly or whole summer (May 28-July 31) placements.

Compensation: \$400 per week. The Camp Health Care Professional will also receive dedicated, private lodging and meals.
