

# Benefit Information for EVSD Employees

#### HEALTHCARE BENEFITS

Employees who meet the eligibility criteria outlined in <u>Chapter 182-31 WAC</u> have access to medical, dental, vision, supplemental life, and supplemental disability insurance through the School Employee Benefit Board (<u>SEBB</u>).

### RETIREMENT

All regular, non-substitute employees are enrolled in state retirement plan through the Washington State Department of Retirement Systems (DRS).

### PAID TIME DFF

All regular, non-substitute employees receive paid time off as outlined in their union's Collective Bargaining Agreement.

- EVEA employees receive 12 days of sick/emergency leave and 4 personal leave days each school year, prorated based on their FTE. This is outlined in Article V of the <u>EVEA CBA</u>.
- PSE employees can view the leave allotments for their position in Article VII and Article XI of the <u>PSE CBA</u>.

Substitute employees receive sick leave per RCW 49.46.210.

## **OTHER BENEFITS**

- All regular, (non-substitute) employees receive a monthly <u>VEBA</u> contribution as outlined in their union's Collective Bargaining Agreement.
- Classified employees receive 10-13 paid holidays per year depending on their position, as outlined in the PSE Collective Bargaining Agreement.
- Employees have access to an <u>Employee Assistance Program (EAP)</u> that provides counseling, legal guidance, work-life solutions, and financial resources.
