Lyle Bayley reported the "Open & Operations Plan" was developed following the guidelines set forth by the Idaho State Board of Education as well as the local Southwest District Health. The "Open & Operations Plan" is centered on traditional schooling, with students and teachers in the building. The plan is adaptable in accordance with the level of COVID 19 in the community. Bayley reported starting in the yellow phase will help teachers be ready to start on line and provides a measure of safety for staff and students.
