Lyle Bayley -School COVID-19 Update

4.0 Information/Discussion Item

.1 COVID-19 Update

Mr. Bayley reported the number of new cases district wide is very low with information the district has received from Southwest District Health.

- The average 1.11 cases per 10,000.
- No new cases in Fruitland School District
- Yellow Zone

Mr. Bayley reported he contacted the following school districts in the area to see if they are requiring masks:

Parma School District – Optional masks for 2 weeks prior to spring break.

New Plymouth – Optional masks for 2 weeks prior to spring break.

Bayley reported Parma School District & New Plymouth staff received there COVID vaccine 2 weeks before Fruitland School District.

Chairperson, Kelly Henggeler Mr. Bayley reported the District has had success by having the mask policy in place prior to spring break. Bayley recommended with students and staff coming back from spring break to wait a week before removing the mask mandate to see if the district has a spike of new cases

Chairman, Kelly Henggeler reported at March 8th Regular Board Meeting the Board discussed COVID-19 protocols and received recommendation from Superintendent Bayley. During the action items and under "school COVID-19 update", Matt Frye made a motion to resume five (5) days a week following the earlier approved school calendar and discontinuing the mask mandate when school resumes after spring break. When I restated the motion with the second, I stated there is a motion to go back to five (5) days of school following the school calendar and discontinuing the on-line option after spring break. Is there any further discussion?

Henggeler reported he reached out to ISBA to see what the Board needed to. ISBA recommended holding a Special Board Meeting to rescind/reconsider the motion.
