The School Board toured the FSD buildings on Monday, March 14, 2022. Each building administration discussed areas of need with the Board:

TRANSPORTATION DEPARTMENT

The Board visited Dan Reed, Transportation Supervisor. Mr. Reed talked to the Board about the following:

- Bus Aide.
- Camera's help with behavior issues.
- Have enough bus drivers for bus routes.
- Need trip bus drivers.
- 4 – 2020 buses lease.
- Purchase 2 New Buses – Western Mountain Bus
Possibly use ESSER III Funds
- Like to depreciated out bus 95 and bus 96 (not running)
Don't get good gas mileage.
- Shuttle Busses are scheduled for several activities.
- Staging – Use parking lot across from transportation shop every day.

FRUITLAND EARLY CHILDHOOD CENTER

The Board spoke with Mr. Olsen, Elementary Principal & Luke Vandeberg, ECC Administrative Assistant. Mr. Olsen and Mr. Vandeberg talked to the Board about the following:
