Call Meeting to Order	1.0 Call Meeting to Order: The special board meeting was called to order @ 6:15 p.m. by Trustee Hurrle.
	2.0 Pledge of Allegiance: Trustee Hurrle led those in attendance in the Pledge of Allegiance.
Approval of Board Agenda	3.0 Approval of Board Agenda: A motion was made by Howell and seconded by Dressen to approve the board agenda as presented. The motion was unanimously approved.
Executive Session	4.0 Executive Session:  .1 Pursuant to Idaho Code 74-206 (1)(b) Student Discipline  • Student "D"  Trustee Howell made a motion to enter into executive session to consider the evaluation, dismissal or disciplining of, or to hear complaints or charges brought against, Student "D" under Idaho Code 74-206 (1)(b). The motion was seconded by Dressen.

## **5.0 Action Item:**

- .1 Possible action will be taken regarding Student Discipline.
  - Student "D"

The Fruitland School Board has moved to expel Student "D" for a calendar year. Dates of the expulsion are from June 2, 2022 to June 2, 2023. The basis of this action is Student "D" violation of <u>Idaho Code 33-205</u> whereas the "student's presence at school is detrimental to the health and safety of other pupils."

The Fruitland School Board has executed a "STAY" of expulsion starting June 2, 2022 providing the following conditions are met:

- Student "D" may return to school in the Fall semester of 2022 provided that he completes a "Threat Assessment" and is found not to be a danger at school. This assessment is to be in writing and provided to Superintendent Bayley prior to the start of the 2022-2023 school year.
- Student "D" behavior is within guidelines of school policy for the entire 2022-2023 school year, with none of the conditions outlined in <u>Idaho Code 33-205</u> occurring in his discipline record. Items in 33-205 are:
  - o Habitual Truancy.
  - o Continuously disruptive to school discipline.
  - o Presence at school is detrimental to the health and safety of other pupils.
  - o Be in possession of a deadly or dangerous weapon or firearm on school property.
  - o The student has engaged in violation of the reasonable terms and conditions of the board.
