Mr. Graham recommended that the board accept the resignation of Nick Evans, teacher/coach. David Hilliard made a motion to accept and Miles Mitchell seconded the motion. It passed. 5-0.

Mr. Graham recommended the employment of Richard Strickland, teacher/coach; Dacia Strickland, Primary School teacher; Holly Harding-Smith, English teacher; Paul Edwards, ABC custodian. Mark Canaday made a motion to approve and David Hilliard seconded the motion. It passed 5-0.
