COMMEMORATION OF SCHOOL FACILITIES

The School Board may wish to commemorate a school or District facility by means of a plaque or by naming the facility in accordance with Policy 970. Such commemoration should be reserved only for those individuals who have made a significant contribution to the enhancement of education generally, or to the District in particular, or to the well-being of the District, community, state, or nation.

The following criteria will apply when considering naming a school after, or dedicating a facility to, an individual:

- A. the name should be easily identifiable with the school or facility;
- B. candidates will be of exemplary moral character and have made an outstanding contribution to the local schools, community, state, or nation.

This policy also applies to the naming of any part of a facility. All naming of school property requires approval of the Board. A super majority (71%) of the Board must agree to establish the name of a facility; room; or area as stated above.
