The Bangor Area School District Annual Meeting Agenda Items

1. Change in the Plan of Apportionment of Board Members

A petition conforming to the requirements of Wis. Stats. 8.40 requesting a change in the establishment of a plan of apportionment of school board members was filed with the school district clerk on September 25, 2018. Pursuant to Wis. Stats. 120.02(2) the question of changing the election plan of school board members to the plan requested in the petition will be voted upon at this annual meeting. If at the annual meeting, a resolution based on a petition requesting a change in the election plan of school board members is adopted by a majority vote, school board members shall be elected at the next school board election and thereafter in accordance with the election plan set forth in the petition.

Current Board policy language states that the Board shall consist of seven (7) members with:

- One (1) member from the rural area north of the common Township of Burns boundary extended
- One (1) member from the rural area south of the common Township of Bangor-Township of Burns boundary extended
- one (1) member from the village of Bangor
- one (1) member from the village of Rockland
- three (3) members with no residence requirement other than being a resident of the District.

The question will appear on the annual meeting ballot as follows:

• Should the terms of the three (3) members with no residence restrictions other than being a resident of the District be eventually elected to full terms in different times with the change in terms occurring first in April 2019 as set forth below:

- Member with no residence restrictions other than being a resident of the District in seat "A" would be elected to a full three-year term in 2019 and would stand for an election for a full three-year term in 2022;
- Member with no residence restrictions other than being a resident of the District in seat "B" would be elected to a two-year term in 2019 and then subsequently would stand for an election for a full three-year term in 2021;
- Member with no residence restrictions other than being a resident of the District in seat "C" would be elected to a one-year term in 2019 and then subsequently would stand for an election for a full three-year term in 2020;
- All other members' terms would remain in present form.
