Harlowton Public Schools, School District 16, Wheatland County, Harlowton, Montana maintains that:

The School System shall help the children from all walks of life to gain the knowledge, skills and determination that will enable them to reach their highest potential and to contribute to the welfare of all people.

The School System shall establish and maintain an atmosphere in which all persons can develop attitudes and skills for effective cooperative living, including:

1. Respect for the individual regardless of economic status, intellectual ability, race, creed, color, religion, sex, or age.

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Meal Ticket Prices:

Regular Breakfast \$2.50; Reduced Breakfast \$.30; Adult Breakfast \$2.50
Regular Lunch \$3.50; Reduced Lunch \$.40; Adult Lunch \$4.70; Milk \$.50; a la carte \$.75

Activity Ticket Prices:

Student Activity Tickets are \$50.00 (required for all participants in athletics and pep band). This pass will admit student to most athletic events and assemblies.

Adult Booster Tickets: \$65.00 under age 65. Cost for adults age 65 or older is \$50.00.

The Engineer Family Activity Pass: (2 adults and up to 3 school-age children/students) will cost \$250. Each additional child is \$25. Kindergarten students are free.

Participation Fees for high school students are \$30.00 per activity with a maximum cap of \$75.00 per student. Junior high and elementary students will have a \$25.00 per activity fee charged for all activities with a maximum cap of \$65.00 per student for junior high and a maximum cap of \$60.00 per student for elementary.
