Regular Board Meeting

The Schaller-Crestland Board of Education, along with the Galva-Holstein Board of Education, met in joint session on Monday, July 11, 2022 at 7:00 pm in the Galva-Holstein Media Center, Holstein, IA. The following board members were present: Christy Horan, Kory Blum, Matt Cress, Mike Schmitt (arr. 7:10 pm). Others present: Supt. Bisenius. Absent: Steve Mason

Call to order at 7:01 pm by President Christy Horan.

Motion by Blum, second by Cress to approve the agenda as posted. Motion carried 3-0.

Motion by Cress, second by Blum to approve the June 13, 2022 work session and regular board Meeting minutes as published. Motion carried 3-0.

Motion by Cress, second by Blum to approve the bills as presented. Cress reviewed the bills prior to the meeting. Motion carried 3-0.

Schmitt arrived 7:10 pm.

Financial statements were presented but approval will come after the completion of the audit and state report.

Motion by Cress, second by Schmitt to approve the hiring of Edna Pineda, MS special education aide at \$12.50/hr, Sarah Carlson, MS Library Aide at \$12.00/hr, and position/rate change for Melissa Stamp, MS special education aide at \$13.50/hr. Motion carried 4-0.

Motion by Blum, second by Cress to approve the milk bid submitted by Anderson Erickson Dairy for the 2022-2023 school year. Motion carried 4-0.

Motion by Cress, second by Schmitt to approve the recommended 2022-2023 school year fees as presented. Motion carried 4-0.

Supt. Bisenius updated the boards of his current professional development commitments. Supt. Bisenius also gave a suggestion to the board on utilizing GovDeals.com to sell any unused or items the school would like to dispose of.

In other discussion, Guarentee Gutters have donated the entire project for the new bus barn as an appreciation for all the business that the Schaller community has given them over the past year. This was very much appreciated!
