President Horan addressed the public on public comment. She advised the public to listen to the discussion from the meeting first and then they will open the work session to the public to speak.

Motion by Blum, second by Mason to approve the following non-certified staff: Tabitha Ballou-Elm associate-\$11/hour, Natasha Foster-Elm associate-\$11/hour, Nicole Domino-Cook-\$11/hour, Chris Gardner-Cook-\$11/hour, Paula Steuk-Cook-\$11/hour. Motion carried 5-0.

Motion by Schmitt, second by Cress to approve the hiring of Johnathan Hagen, Transportation Director, at a salary of \$43,000. Motion carried 5-0.

Motion by Mason, second by Blum to approve the following coaching contracts: Tyler Merical-JH Football-\$2240, Mason Goebel-JH Football-\$2240, Tricia Vohs-JH Volleyball-\$2240, and Parker Preul-JH Student Council-\$320. Motion carried 5-0.

Motion by Cress, second by Mason to approve the hiring of architect, FEH. Slight discussion on the architects. Blum didn't feel the board received a good answer on the price of the architects. Adam advised the board that the price would depend on what the board decided to do. Bob wasn't able to have those numbers but Bob did end up with 16% with GH projects. Cress added that it could potentially be more with Bob based on those numbers. President Horan called for a roll call vote to approve FEH as the architect. Ayes: Blum, Schmitt, Horan, Cress, and Mason. Nays: None. Motion carried 5-0.

In other discussion, Blum would like to see the meetings in the future streamed so that the public can see exactly what the board is discussing. President Horan advised Supt. Bisenius to see what options we have and the technology needed.
