


Advice on Head Lice for the Harvard University Community*:

Head lice are small insects that live amongst the scalp hair of human beings. They feed only on blood. They're far more common on young children (kindergarten – 4th grade levels), but occasionally are found on teenagers and adults. They may cause itching on some people, but they do not transmit any infections.
