INTRODUCTION

Logan View Public Schools is a Class III school district that covers an approximate area of 200 square miles and serves students in Burt, Cuming, Dodge, and Washington counties. Logan View Public Schools is fully accredited by the Nebraska State Department of Education.

The 2017-2018 school year marked the sixth year that Logan View Public Schools served its entire student body at the Logan View campus.

STAFF

For 2017-2018, Logan View Public Schools was staffed by approximately 80 full or part-time certified and classified staff. Certificated staff included approximately 50 teachers, a superintendent, a K-6 principal, a 7-12 principal, an assistant principal/activities director, a guidance counselor and a school psychologist. Approximately 52% of Logan View's teaching staff has a Masters Degree, the statewide percentage is approximately 55%. The LVPS teaching staff has an average of 16.3 years of teaching experience compared to the state average of approximately 14.0 years of experience. The classified staff at LVPS includes a full-time nurse, secretaries, para-educators, cooks, bus drivers, and maintenance staff.

STUDENT CHARACTERISTICS

The official, K-12 enrollment for 2017-2018 was 547 students. Approximately 38% of LVPS students qualified for Free/Reduced-Price meals; the statewide percentage was approximately 46%. Approximately 16% of LVPS students qualified for Special Education services while the statewide percentage was approximately 15%. Approximately 4% of LVPS students were classified as English Language Learners while the statewide percentage was approximately 8%.

AFFILIATIONS

Logan View Public Schools is a member of the East Husker Conference and is classified as a Class C school by the Nebraska School Activities Association. LVPS is served by Educational Service Unit No. 2 in Fremont.

MISSION & SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT

The Mission of Logan View Public Schools is to educate life-long learners in a nurturing, challenging and disciplined environment.

School improvement goals include improved performance in both Reading and Math.
