NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that such amounts shall be certified and returned to the County Clerk of Fayette County on or before the last Tuesday of December, 2017 and that the President and Secretary of this Board of Education are instructed to sign the Certificate of Tax Levy in the form prescribed by law".
