Motion by Morrison, seconded by Kistler that the following resolution establishing the 2015 Tax Levy be adopted: "The Board of Education of Brownstown Community Unit School District No. 201, Fayette County, State of Illinois, ascertained and determined, and does hereby ascertain and Adopt

determine that the sum of Three Hundred Fifty Seven Thousand, Seven Hundred One Dollars (\$357,701.00) must be raised for Educational purposes; the sum of One Hundred Eleven Thousand, One Hundred Ninety Eight Dollars (\$111,198.00) must be raised for Operations and Maintenance purposes; the sum of Thirty Eight Thousand, Eight Hundred Eighty One Dollars (\$38,881.00) must be raised for Transportation purposes; the sum of Nine Thousand, Seven Hundred Twenty Dollars (\$9,720.00) must be raised for Working Cash purposes; the sum of Seventy Five Thousand Dollars (\$75,000.00) must be raised for Illinois Municipal Retirement purposes; the sum of Sixty Thousand Dollars (\$60,000.00) must be raised for Social Security purposes; the sum of Nine Thousand, Seven Hundred Twenty Dollars (\$9,720.00) must be raised for Fire Prevention and Safety purposes; the sum of One Hundred Ten Thousand Dollars (\$110,000.00) must be raised for Tort Immunity purposes; the sum of Seven Thousand, Seven Hundred Seventy Six Dollars (\$7,776.00) must be raised for Special Education purposes; the sum of Nine Thousand, Seven Hundred Twenty Dollars (\$9,720.00) must be raised for Lease, Purchase, Rent purposes; the sum of One Hundred Sixty Nine Thousand, Six Hundred Nine Dollars (\$169,609.00) must be raised for Debt Service purposes. NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that such amounts shall be certified and Returned to the County Clerk of Fayette County on or before the last Tuesday of December, 2015 and that the President and Secretary of this Board of Education are instructed to sign the Certificate of Tax Levy in the form prescribed by law".
