

Tiger Robotics History

Tiger Robotics was started in 2012 by Coach Chris Stewart. It started with a single First Lego League team and an after school club made up of 10 middle school kids in all.

This year Tiger Robotics consisted of 14 teams in two different leagues. Members come from South Middle School, North Middle School, Harrisburg High School, and all 6 elementary schools with over 60 students participating in some way. This group has accrued four state championships, 6 invitations to the world championships, 18 invitations to the national championships, two state excellence award, and three state design awards.

Now campers can learn from these experienced team members in our fifth annual summer robotics camp.

-Basic robotics programming camp.

This camp is best for those new to robotics or too young for a team.

-Sensor Camp. This option is for those who have been through programming camp and are interested in learning more advanced programming techniques using sensors to help the robot navigate its environment and interact with game pieces.

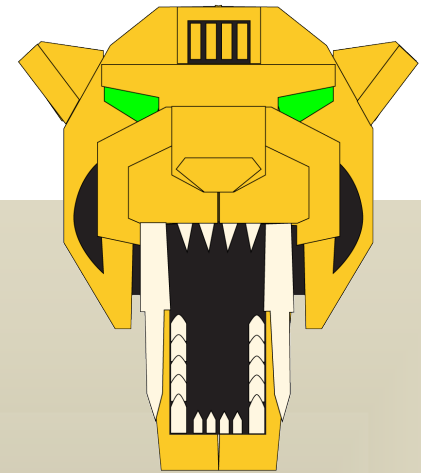
