





Business Department Report By: Dr. Philip Kenter

BUSINESS DEPARTMENT

- Awaiting Requests for Proposals for internal auditing services to be returned to us from qualified accounting firms. Due date is April 8. Audit Committee will then convene to review all received proposals and set up meeting date and times to meet with proposers.
- The entire Business Department is working closely together to structure the 2019-2020 Proposed Budget and related powerpoint presentations to the Board, checking and double-checking all numbers and data.
- Made arrangements with Eastern Suffolk BOCES to perform bilingual translation services on all budget-related materials to be presented to the community in compliance with recent Federal requirements.

BUSINESS DEPARTMENT

- Working closely with our Claims Auditor in revamping the checklist we recently created when reviewing our bi-weekly payroll and benefits to ensure compliance with our Corrective Action Plan. This is a continuous work in progress as we add and change the format, sequence and items to be evaluated. We have already successfully performed two payroll audits using this new checklist.
- Arranging our pre-audit visit from Cullen and Danowski, our External Auditors for one week wherein they will request and commence reviewing certain documents from us in advance of the actual audit.
- Working with Finance Manager and Eastern Suffolk BOCES in anticipation of our May conversion to our new accounting software entitled "NVision".



FACILITIES UPDATE





Sag Harbor Learning Center

- Branch services has finished removing the residual asbestos floor mastic.
- Tim Bowker construction manager representing the IBI architecture group has been on site daily and showing the building to perspective bidding contractors.
- We are anticipating bid opening on Tuesday, March 26, 2019.



Elementary School

- We had steam pipe leaks in classrooms 212 and 214.
 Branch services safely removed the pipe wrap and
 Best climate repaired the steam pipes. In room 214
 we had JC Broderick test the classroom for mold and
 asbestos. All test results came back negative and
 room was cleared for instruction.
- Moore Roofing has repaired winter storm wind damaged shingles and fascia capping on one of the dog house dormers.
- Our grounds department have been busy replacing gate latches and hinges.



Pierson Middle/High School

- Roof repairs that were originally scheduled for the February break have been rescheduled for the April break.
- We anticipate removing the temporary winter fencing around the back field the first week of April with full usage restored on April 8, 2019.



Pierson Middle/High School

 Arrow Steel Windows had a concrete contractor replace 6 sections of sidewalk that were damaged while the new windows were being installed. The repairs were of no cost to the school district.







Pierson Window Project Update

With the the voter approved 2017 Capital Reserve Window Project, we have a change order to utilize some of the remaining window funds to complete the windows in the Pierson "snake" hallway leading to the high school gym that are corroded and boiler room window overlooking the courtyard.
