MINUTES AND RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING SALE OF BONDS

The Board of Education of Independent School District Number 2 of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, met in Special Session at the Offices of the Board, Board of Education Building, Sand Springs Public Schools, 11 West Broadway, Sand Springs, Oklahoma, in said School District on the 11th day of March, 2019, at 12:00 o'clock Noon

Notice of this special meeting was given in writing to the County Clerk of Tulsa County, Oklahoma at 1:07 o'clock p.m. on the 28th day of February, 2019, forty-eight (48) hours or more prior to this meeting, and public notice of this meeting, setting forth the date, time, place and agenda was posted on the front door of the Board of Education Building, in prominent view and open to the public twenty-four (24) hours each day, seven (7) days each week at 11:00 o'clock a.m. on the 8th day of March, 2019, being twenty-four (24) hours or more prior to this meeting, excluding Saturdays, Sundays, and State designated legal holidays, all in compliance with the Oklahoma Open Meeting Act (as attached hereto).

Said Resolution was thereupon signed by the President, attested by the Clerk, sealed with the seal of said School District, and is as follows:

RESOLUTION

A resolution fixing the amount of bonds to mature each year, fixing the time and place the bonds are to be sold, and authorizing the clerk to give notice of said sale as required by law.

WHEREAS, the issuance of \$42,160,000 of General Obligation Building Bonds by Independent School District No. 2 of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, has been duly authorized at an election held on the 13th day of October, 2009, for that purpose; and

WHEREAS, \$28,210,000 of the \$42,160,000 has previously been sold, issued and delivered, and the Board of Education of Independent School District No. 2 of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, now desires to sell a tenth installment of \$2,325,000; and

WHEREAS, the issuance of \$31,550,000 of General Obligation Building Bonds by Independent School District Number 2 of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, has been duly authorized at an election held on the 5th day of March, 2019, for that purpose; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Education of Independent School District Number 2 of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, having determined at the time that the election was called to authorize the \$31,550,000 of General Obligation Building Bonds, that it would issue the bonds in separate series, with the first series of \$3,070,000 to be issued immediately; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Education of Independent School District Number 2 of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, pursuant to Title 62, Oklahoma Statutes 2011, Section 354, desires to sell at this time \$5,395,000 in bonds consisting of a combined issue of \$2,325,000 of Building Bonds authorized at an election held on the 13th day of October, 2009; and \$3,070,000 of Building Bonds authorized at an election held on the 5th day of March, 2019;

Now, therefore, be it resolved by the Board of Education of Independent School District Number 2 of Tulsa County, Oklahoma:

SECTION 1.

That the \$5,395,000 of General Obligation Combined Purpose Bonds of Independent School District Number 2 of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, portions of which were voted on the 13th day of October, 2009, and the 5th day of March, 2019, shall be offered for sale at the Offices of the Board, Board of Education Building, Sand Springs Public Schools, 11 West Broadway, Sand Springs, Oklahoma, on the 16th day of April, 2019, at 11:45 o'clock a.m.; said Bonds to become due:

\$1,345,000 in two years from their date, and \$1,350,000 annually each year thereafter until paid.
