


And though she's left us all behind. Our Elm still lives within our minds.






#### Administration

#### TRIBUTE TO BLUEBOY

Marvin Richie, or "Blueboy," as he was known by his friends, served this community not only as City Marshal, but as a businessman, a church member, and devoted husband and father. He spent many of his off duty hours counseling teenagers and helping others in various ways. He was a generous man — compassionate, and sincerely interested in people.

Marvin's patrol car was often surrounded by students during lunch period or after school asking questions or simply visiting with him. He was a great asset to this school, spending much of his time directing traffic in the crosswalk or controlling speed in the school zone, giving parents and teachers a great sense of security for the students. As for his influence on teenagers, one person said, "He had a heart for the teenagers," as he worked with them in many ways.

Like many others who have given their lives for a greater purpose, Marvin Richie will be remembered and missed, and his contribution to the community will be imprinted in the hearts of its people for many years.
