Boating Safety Certification Course

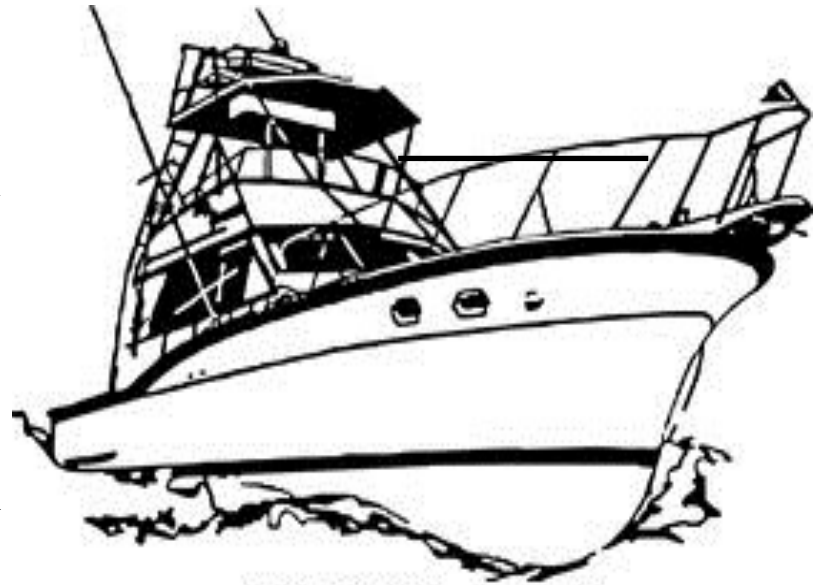
Learn boater education in a classroom setting from a game warden, AND receive boating safety certification issued by the Georgia

Department of Natural Resources. All persons born on or after January 1, 1998 that operate any motorized vessel on the waters of the state must have completed an approved boat education course prior to such operation.

This course will certify students to operate vessels on state waters as well as teach students important lessons in water safety, navigation and safe operation, required equipment, emergency procedures and other responsibilities of a boat operator.

The class will be offered over the course of two nights, students must attend both sessions to be eligible for certification. (Students will need a GA DNR Customer ID Number to complete the course.)
