Discussion of Action Plan for Social Media Policy Components:

- Our meeting began with a brief discussion of how we would approach the task ahead. We would like to meet approximately every 7-10 days for an hour until our work is completed.
- When determining policy statements we need to take into consideration if what we are proposing is enforceable and legal. Also, if it reflects the vision and mission of GITS.
- After a discussion of potential approaches to our policy work, which included additional research options, we decided to begin with policy 1613 and review the options as presented by NEOLA.
- Here is a summary of our conclusions:
 - 1st --bullet-include as is
 - 2nd --strike because it is implicitly included in the first statement.
 - 3rd—keep and include as is
 - 4th—include as is(moral clause)
 - 5th—include as is
 - 6th—HOLD and revisit. ? Parent permission—*Teri will look into current practice*
 - 7th—include as is
 - 8th—HOLD and revisit. Comment: Should end with approval of Superintendent
 - 9th—HOLD and revisit. Federal law.
 - 10th—include as is

Other:

Sue Jeffries, of the GITS technology staff stopped in to introduce herself. She gave us a brief update on her work in the district over the summer months and the change in procedure for student log-ins. She explained the programs Deep Freeze & Iprint and we spoke of a time in the future where it might be appropriate for her to join in on our discussions regarding social media usage.
