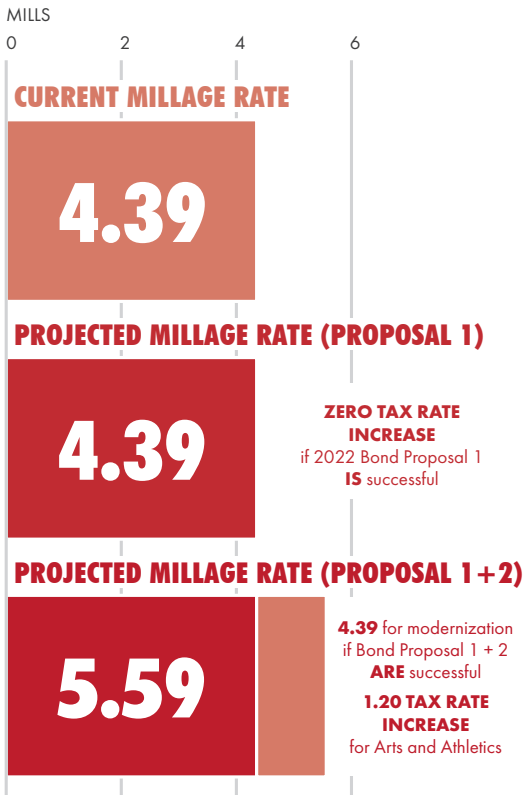




PROPOSAL 1 + PROPOSAL 2 = PERSONALIZED LEARNING FOR OUR KIDS.

As part of the Grosse Ile Township Schools Strategic Plan, the District is dedicated to investing in our kids. This includes providing safe, future-focused learning environments and facilities. Proposal 1 focuses on critical needs and modernization. Proposal 2 focuses on staying competitive by upgrading performing arts and athletic facilities. Below is a breakdown of the tax rate estimates for each proposal on the ballot.

OUR KIDS. OUR COMMUNITY.

The Board of Education is asking voters to consider two bond proposals totaling **\$72.39 million** to address critical needs and improve district-wide facilities while continuing Grosse Ile Township Schools' tradition of excellence. If approved by the voters, Bond Proposal 1 (\$55.45 million) would result in an estimated **Zero Tax Rate Increase** over the debt millage taxes levied in 2022 and focus on critical needs and modernization. If voters approve both Bond Proposal 1 and 2 totaling \$72.89 million, the result would be an estimated **1.2 Mill Tax Rate Increase** over the debt millage taxes levied in 2022 and focus on staying competitive with performing arts and athletic facilities in addition to the projects referenced for Bond Proposal 1.

PROPOSAL 1: CRITICAL NEEDS & MODERNIZATION

Modernization	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Utilize a single K-5 building with classroom and gym/cafeteria additions Construct a new outdoor learning area on the Detroit River Create modernized innovation spaces, STEM, and other personalized learning environments
Infrastructure Improvements	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Update mechanical and electrical systems Upgrade interiors, including lighting, flooring, ceiling, and plumbing Replace roofing
Safety & Security	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Upgrade safety/security features, including door hardware and access control improvements Build campus connector between middle and high schools to improve traffic flow Upgrade parking lots and drop off areas to improve traffic flow
Technology & Equipment	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Refresh learning devices for students and staff Upgrade technology infrastructure Invest in new maintenance equipment and buses

PROPOSAL 2: COMPETITIVE EDUCATIONAL FACILITIES

Arts & Athletics	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Improve middle and high schools athletic facilities, including synthetic turf Upgrade high school stadium Upgrade gym and locker room at the middle and high schools Upgrade performing arts auditoriums, including audio/visual, lighting, and stage equipment at the middle and high schools
