## SUMMER SCHOOL 2019 -- GRADES 1-2

Dear parents/guardians,

Summer School 2019 is coming. Our goal is to offer classes that are both fun and educational. This year's session will run from Monday, June 10th to Thursday, June 20th, with no classes on Friday, June 14th. There are 3 class periods lasting 80 minutes each. There are no fees for any classes.

To enroll, complete the enrollment sheet at the back of this packet. It is very important that you indicate a **first, second, and third choice** for each of the three periods because some classes fill quickly. Note that the grade level listed is the grade your child will be entering in the fall. Some classes are only open for certain grade levels. Students will be accepted on a first-come, first served basis. **Enrollment begins at 7:20 a.m. Wednesday, May 1st. No registrations will be accepted before that time.** Once registration begins, I will regularly update the Barneveld School District webpage with information on which classes are still available. **Registration ends Friday, May 10th.**

It is possible that the construction project may impact where we hold classes, and where children may be dropped off and picked up. We will provide you with that information through email and the Barneveld School District webpage when it becomes available.

## Summer School 2019 Grades 1-2

**Jumpstart First Grade (Mrs. Fingerson)** This class offers an exciting experience for children entering first grade. Children will have opportunities to strengthen and enrich foundational literacy skills and concepts through a variety of fun and exciting activities. Children will be engaged in a plethora of activities to include practicing sight words, listening to and reading great books, and a slew of phonics games and activities. **\*\*\*Grade 1 Only\*\*\***

**All Aboard the USA Express (Mrs. Fingerson)** This class offers an exciting experience for children wanting to learn more about special places in the good ole' USA! Children will learn about many historical landmarks in the United States including Mt. Rushmore, Washington DC, the Grand Canyon, and so much more. Get ready for some fun-filled facts and activities while boarding the USA Express! **Grades 1-2**

**Marvelous Math (Mrs. Fingerson)** This class will offer the experience of math as never before, with hands-on activities, skill boosters, adventurous journeys, puzzles, games, mysteries to solve, and many other fun activities. We will learn to be great mathematicians! **Grades 1-2**

**Write ON! (Mrs. McGowan)** If you love to tell stories, draw, and discuss ideas, this is the class for YOU! We will be looking at a variety of authors and illustrators that inspire us! So grab your pens and some paper and let's WRITE ON! **Grades 1-2**

**Cooking in the Kitchen with Books (Mrs. McGowan)** Have you ever read a story that makes you hungry or eager to cook? This is the class for you! Students will have the opportunity to share exciting children's books and prepare related "tasty treats." They will be practicing math and reading skills, as well as developing good work habits in the kitchen. **Grades 1-2**

**Wild and Wacky Science (Mrs. McGowan)** Join us for some exciting experiments! Students will be engaged with different types of playful and hands-on activities! We will be learning about a variety of science topics! Join me for a wild, wacky, and fun science class! **Grades 1-2**

**Movement Madness (Mrs. Eaton)** Do you like to chase, run, play games and have fun? Let's experience together different exercises and activities that will give you a well-balanced connection between fitness and health. We will practice exploring various methods of exercising with lots of different PE equipment, such as, mats, balls, scooters, jump ropes, swinging/climbing rope, juggling scarves, PE apps, ets. Come join the fun and learn more about movement themes and principles. **Grades 1-2**

**Nature, Gardens, and Art (Mrs. Archie)** Do you like to look at caterpillars and flowers, and plant seeds and watch them grow? We will learn about where food comes from, and how to plan a garden. We will also be using our artistic skills to create cool animals and insects, make mosaic containers and paint planters.

**Grades 1-2**

**Basketball Camp (Mr. Schulting)** Work on the basic skills of basketball. The fundamentals of dribbling, passing, shooting, defense and rebounding will be the focus of this class. There will also be games played where the basic rules and fundamentals will be the focus. **\*\*\*Grade 2 Only\*\*\* (Mr. Schulting will be walking the kids up to the park for this class each day)**

**Pinata Party (Mrs. Meyers)** Bring your creative minds and artistic abilities. We will create different shaped pinatas for you enjoy. We will learn the best methods to creating them, how they stick together, and where the first pinatas came from and the traditions they were used for. **\*\*\*Grade 2 Only\*\*\***

**Mask Making (Mr. Larson)** Come learn about masks from around the world and create your own! Student's have the option to create their very own mask using plaster or paper mache and will decorate using paints, feathers, glitter and all those other fun crafty things! **Grades 1-2**

**Build It! (Ms. Reeson)** If you want to "Build It" with Legos, you should come to this fun and engaging class! Students will be given basic challenges and encouraged to build creatively in a hands-on environment. Students will have the opportunity to "free build", but will also have the opportunity to try some new challenges. Students will be given a variety of methods to work through problem solving to ensure that students are able to learn, but also ensure that children have a fun experience. **Grades 1-2**

**Cooperative Games (Ms. Reeson)** Have you heard about cooperative games? In a cooperative game, players work together to win! The fun comes from the camaraderie and challenge of the game! Cooperative games range from board games to circle games to PE games to digital games and more. They are all based on the principle that it can be just as much fun—well, actually more fun—to play with each other than against each other! **Grades 1-2**
