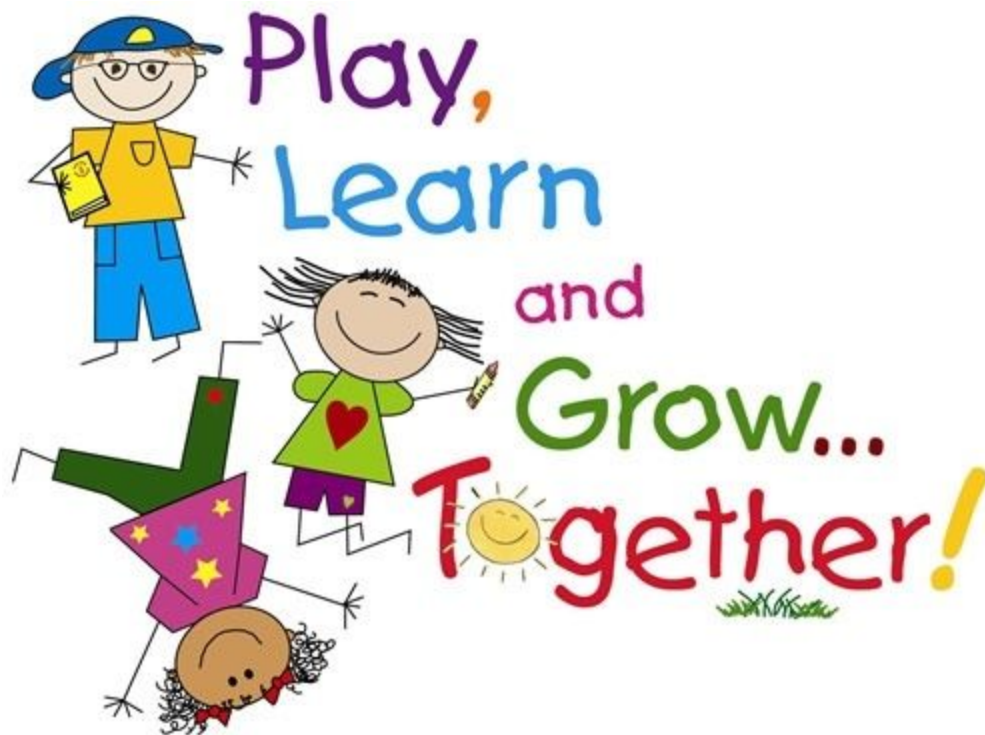

## SUMMER SCHOOL 2019 -- GRADES 3-5

Dear parents/guardians,

Summer School 2019 is coming. Our goal is to offer classes that are both fun and educational. This year's session will run from Monday, June 10th to Thursday, June 20th, with no classes on Friday, June 14th. There are 3 class periods lasting 80 minutes each. There are no fees for any classes.

To enroll, complete the enrollment sheet at the back of this packet. It is very important that you indicate a **first, second, and third choice** for each of the three periods because some classes fill quickly. Note that the grade level listed is the grade your child will be entering in the fall. Some classes are only open for certain grade levels. Students will be accepted on a first-come, first served basis. **Enrolment begins at 7:20 a.m. Wednesday, May 1st. No registrations will be accepted before that time.** Once registration begins, I will regularly update the Barneveld School District webpage with information on which classes are still available. **Registration ends Friday, May 10th.**

It is possible that the construction project may impact where we hold classes, and where children may be dropped off and picked up. We will provide you with that information through email and the Barneveld School District webpage when it becomes available.

**Summer School 2019**  
**Grades 3-5**

**Pinata Party (Mrs. Meyers)** Bring your creative minds and artistic abilities. We will create different shaped pinatas for you enjoy. We will learn the best methods to creating them, how they stick together, and where the first pinatas came from and the traditions they were used for. **Grades 3-5**

**Movement Madness (Mrs. Eaton)** Do you like to chase, run, play games and have fun? Let's experience together different exercises and activities that will give you a well-balanced connection between fitness and health. We will practice exploring various methods of exercising with lots of different PE equipment, such as, mats, balls, scooters, jump ropes, swinging/climbing rope, juggling scarves, PE apps, ets. Come join the fun and learn more about movement themes and principles. **Grades 3-5**

**Nature, gardens and art (Mrs. Archie)** Do you like to look at caterpillars and flowers, and plant seeds and watch them grow? We will learn about where food comes from, and how to plan a garden. We will also be using our artistic skills to create cool animals and insects, make mosaic containers and paint planters. **Grades 3-5**

**Memories and me (Mrs. Archie)** Do you remember a special vacation, or birthday party, or trip to the water park? We will be making memory scrapbooks about yourself, your family and your friends. **Grades 3-5**

**Duct Tape (Mrs. Faltz)** We will use duct tape to create some fun crafts . We will do some old crafts we have done before, but there will be new projects! Find out what amazing things you can make with duct tape. **Grades 3-5**

**Beaded Art (Mrs. Gordon)** Following simplistic colored patterns will result in beaded puppies, beaded dolphins, beaded letters, beaded numbers, and other radical bead designs! Bead designs look great on backpacks, as decorations in your room, or for gifts! Simply follow the pattern, apply the beads, add heat, and voila! Beaded art is a class you don't want to miss! **Grades 3-5**

**Loom Knitting/Crocheting (Mrs. Faltz)** For the crafty student -- Students will be able to make headbands, hats, scarves, and other neat things either by knitting or simple crochet. Everything will be provided to make your projects. This is a fun and easy skill to learn. Students who took this class last year can take it again this year. **Grades 3-5**

**H"app"y Camper (Ms. Mieden)** Be a H"app"y Camper! We will be using all kinds of educational iPad apps, with new ones added daily. Draw, create, read, play music - we will have lots of learning fun. **Grades 3-5**

**Beginning Sewing (Mrs. Faltz)** Did you ever want to learn how to sew? Now is your chance. All you need is to bring a sewing machine and some sewing supplies. Mrs. Faltz will give out material lists before school is out. Possible projects: Tote, triangle bag, pillow case, pillow and cover, clothes (shorts, lounge pants) blankets, butterfly, football, ice cream cone, shark, or mermaid. **You will need to supply your own materials and sewing machine. You must also know how to thread and wind a bobbin.** **Grades 4-5**

**Engineering Unmake (Mr. Sturnick)** Do you like to take things apart to see how it works? Better yet, what about putting it back together to see if it works again. Engineering is all about creating, solving problems, inventing, and dreaming of new things. This summer we will be tearing apart new electronic devices, household appliances, and motors. We'll even try putting them back together. You can take this class if you took the Engineering class last summer. **Grade 5**

**Flicks and Fiction (Ms. Kittoe)** Do you love to read? We will journey through the lives of some of our favorite characters. We will be reading a book and watching the movie. Comparing the two and doing activities centered around both. Week 1 - Because of Winn Dixie (PG) Week 2 - Bridge to Terabithia (PG) **Grades 3-5**

**Latch Hook Art (Mrs. Gordon)** Use math and reading skills to create a beautiful piece of artwork. Latch hooking is a crafty art that requires thought and patience. Students will be given the hook to use, but will need to bring along their first project they would like to make on day 1. **Grades 3-5**

**Wisconsin Ecology and Nature (Mr. Sturnick)** Learn all about the unique and fascinating animals and plants of Wisconsin. . What part do these living things play in keeping our environment healthy? We'll do fun activities with fur, skin, bones, and teeth. **Grades 4-5 Only**

**Jewelry Making (Mr. Larson)** Do you want to be adorned with items you create? Jewelry making will look at jewelry throughout history and create our very own using different braiding techniques. Students created their own pendants and beads out of clay, and use other different beads in the jewelry they design. **Grades 3-5**

**Board Games Galore (Ms. Mieden)** Do you love to play board games. In this class we will learn the rules on how to play many board games and play them. Some of the games included will be: Monopoly, Checkers/Chess, Battleship, Clue, Yahtzee, and many more. **Grades 3-5**

**Science Activities Including Physics and Flight (Mr. Sturnick)** We will spend our days doing different experiments in science. We will explain why things happen. We will work with things such as heat, light, waves, motion, and energy. **Grade 5 Only**

**Cards, Cards, and More Cards (Mrs. Meyers)** Do you love to play card games? This is the class for you. We will be playing games like Kings Corner, 500, golf, Garbage, Euchre, and many more. We will look at the different strategies to the games as well as how math is a part of each game. **Grades 3-5**

**Basketball Camp (Mr. Schulting)** Work on the basic skills of basketball. The fundamentals of dribbling, passing, shooting, defense and rebounding will be the focus of this class. There will also be games played where the basic rules and fundamentals will be the focus. **Grades 3-4 (Mr. Schulting will be walking the kids up to the park for this class each day)**

**Around the World in 8 Days (Ms. Mieden)** Have you ever wanted to travel the world? We will explore different countries. We will dig deep into their customs, traditions, foods, and regions. We will do activities and try foods from around the world. **Grades 3-5**

**Lego Fun (Mrs. Gordon)** Legos are tons of fun. We will have daily projects to design amazing structures and devices. Students will learn to follow detailed directions, and develop spatial awareness. **Grades 3-5**

**Surfing and Soaring Into Summer (Ms. Kittoe)** Daily activities in each subject area (reading, writing, math, science and social studies) based on the surfing theme and soaring theme. **Grades 3-5**

**Games With Math (Mr. Schulting)** Do you enjoy playing games? Do you love math? In this class we will play many different types of games and see how math is involved in games. **Grades 3-5**

**Introduction to Painting (Mr. Larson)** Students will have the opportunity to paint and paint and paint! We will look at different themes and subject matter and students will learn new painting techniques. Watercolors, tempera, and acrylic paint will be explored. **Grades 3-5**

**Harry Potter and the Sorcerer's Stone (Ms. Kittoe)** If you love everything Harry Potter this is the class for you. We will be reading and doing activities to go along with the novel. **Grades 3-5**

**Cooperative Games (Ms. Reeson)** Have you heard about cooperative games? In a cooperative game, players work together to win! The fun comes from the camaraderie and challenge of the game! Cooperative games range from board games to circle games to PE games to digital games and more. They are all based on the principle that it can be just as much fun—well, actually more fun—to play with each other than against each other! **Grades 3-5**
