Summer School 2019--Entering Kindergarten

Dear Parents:

The kindergarten summer school class will be held **June 10-June 20 (no class on June 14th)**. These classes are for students who will be enrolling in kindergarten this fall. Classes will be held **Monday through Thursday** from **8am-12pm**. There will be two sections during the four hour block --"A Whale of a Tale" will be taught by Mrs. Kleimenhagen, and "Commotion in the Ocean" by Mrs. Carden. This is an opportunity to help your child work on some math, science, and reading readiness skills. To enroll in summer school 2019, simply complete the pre-enrollment sheet enclosed in this booklet. Students will be accepted on a **first-come, first-served** basis. There is no fee this year for the class. We must have your registration forms in by **Friday, May 3rd** so we can order supplies. Kindergarten Summer School 2019

Class descriptions: The four hour block will be divided into 2 sections. A recess and snack time will be built into the block.

A Whale of a Tale

A Whale of a Tale is geared exclusively toward children entering kindergarten. The emphasis is on building and reinforcing reading skills. We will "swim" through fun-filled ocean related activities with songs, stories, and phonetic activities to help students cultivate a love of reading. A Whale of a Tale is taught by Mrs. Kleimenhagen. Please note this class has two sections from 8am to 10am or 10 a.m. to 12 p.m.

Commotion in the Ocean

Commotion in the Ocean is geared exclusively toward children entering kindergarten and is a hands-on, age appropriate class where skills and activities are introduced to expose and reinforce basic math skills. Through puzzles, games, and skill builder activities, students get an extra boost in math with an emphasis on counting, number sense, patterning and sorting. This class is taught by Mrs. Carden. Please note this class has two sections from 8am to 10am or 10 am to 12 p.m.

Note: We will randomly assign your child to one of the sections to start the day. Students will switch to the other section at 10 a.m.
