Regular Board of Education Meeting March 13, 2019

- 1. The regular meeting of the Abingdon-Avon CUSD 276 Board of Education was held on March 13, 2019. The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. with Brooks presiding. The following members were present: Craver, Terwilliger, Quinn, Serven, Mannon, Kreider, and Brooks.

 - 2. 2019-2020 Calendar Update: Without concrete direction from the State, Dr. Curry is unable to present a definitive 2019-2020 calendar at this time. He has two calendars ready for either the new 176 day or standard 174 student attendance requirement.

 Tentative dates include a student start date of August 19th and end of year date on May 22nd. There are currently 8 Emergency Days built-in with a potential end date of June 1st, 2020.
 - 3. Summer Project Update: Roof Bids for both Hedding Grade School and Abingdon-Avon High School will be released on Friday, March 15 with a three week bid window. Tuck-pointing/Mortar work at AAMS will be resuming as the weather begins to warm up. Dr. Curry informed the Board that last Friday, the boiler at AAMS failed. After MSI diagnosed the issue, the boiler was restarted by the end of the day.
 - 4. Conference Discussion: The Board was given an opportunity to express any concerns regarding accepting an invitation to the LTC. Principal Weedman presented information regarding the two conferences.
 - 5. Policy 7-270 Discussion: The Board intends to adopt IASB Policy 7-270 at the April Meeting.
 - 6. Track Uniform Replacement. \$938.50 20 Uniforms
 - 7. Soccer Uniforms. \$2200 30 Uniforms
