 WHEREAS, it is the plan of a number of PUBLIC-SCHOOL DISTRICTS and the
 MADISON-ONEIDA BOCES (the "BOCES") during the 2023-2024 school year to bid
 jointly for the purchase of various types of computers and technology commodities
 (the "Commodities"); and

WHEREAS, the Jefferson-Lewis-Hamilton-Herkimer-Oneida BOCES ("the School District") is desirous of participating in the joint bidding of the Commodities, as authorized by General Municipal Law, Article 5- G; and

WHEREAS, this Board of Education has received and reviewed the Cooperative Bid Procedures ("the Procedures") governing its right and responsibilities should it elect to participate in the joint bidding of commodities; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that in accordance with Cooperative Bid Procedures the Board of Education agrees to award bid purchase item purchases according to the recommendation of the BOCES if such award is in the best interest of the school district.

9. Approve the Revenue Anticipation Note Resolution A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF UP TO [\$4,000,000] IN REVENUE ANTICIPATION NOTES OF THE BOARD OF COOPERATIVE EDUCATIONAL SERVICES OF THE SOLE SUPERVISORY DISTRICT, JEFFERSON-LEWIS-HAMILTON-HERKIMER-ONEIDA COUNTIES, NEW YORK IN ANTICIPATION OF THE COLLECTION OF REVENUES OTHER THAN REAL ESTATE TAXES OR ASSESSMENTS TO BE COLLECTED DURING THE FISCAL YEAR 2023-2024

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of Cooperative Educational Services of the Sole Supervisory District, Jefferson-Lewis-Hamilton-Herkimer-Oneida Counties, New York ("BOCES") as follows:

<u>Section 1</u>. There are hereby authorized to be issued up to [\$4,000,000] in Revenue Anticipation Notes (the "Notes") which are being issued in anticipation of the collection of revenues from the component districts of BOCES.

<u>Section 2</u>. Such revenues are due and payable in BOCES' fiscal year commencing July 1, 2023 and ending June 30, 2024.

<u>Section 3</u>. The amount of uncollected revenues against which the Notes are authorized to be issued is in excess of [\$4,000,000].

Section 4. The amount of the Notes to be issued shall not exceed [\$4,000,000].

Section 5. The period of maturity of the Notes will not exceed one year, and the maturity date of the Notes will not be later than June 30, 2024. The Notes may be renewed from time to time, but each renewal shall be for a period not exceeding one year and in no event shall the Notes, or the renewals thereof, extend beyond the close of the second fiscal year succeeding the fiscal year in which the Notes are issued. The Notes shall not be renewed in an amount in excess of the difference between the amount of uncollected or unreceived revenue in anticipation of which they were issued and the

amount of any other outstanding revenue anticipation notes issued in anticipation of the collection or receipt of such revenues.

<u>Section 6</u>. The faith and credit of BOCES shall be and are hereby pledged for the punctual payment of the principal of and interest due on the Notes as the same shall become due and payable.

<u>Section 7</u>. The Notes shall be issued in such amount and have such terms, form and content, and shall be sold in such manner as may be prescribed by the President of the Board of Directors of BOCES, the Chief Fiscal Officer, consistent with the provisions of the Local Finance Law.

<u>Section 8</u>. The President of the Board of Directors of BOCES, the Chief Fiscal Officer, is hereby authorized to enter into an undertaking for the benefit of the holders of the Notes as required by Securities and Exchange Commission Rule 15c2-12, as amended.

Section 9. This resolution shall take effect immediately.

Results of Voting on the Proposed 2023-2024 BOCES Administrative Budget and Election of Four Members to the

Jefferson-Lewis-Hamilton-Herkimer-Oneida Board of Cooperative Educational Services

On Tuesday, April 25, 2023, seventeen component school boards met to vote on the 2023-2024 proposed BOCES administrative budget and to elect four (4) members to the Board of Cooperative Educational Services. Listed below are the results of the voting:
