Understanding In-County Magnet School Options for Gilchrist County Residents,

All high school Career and Technical Education programs <u>are open to incoming</u> <u>9th-grade students</u> at Bell High School and Trenton High School. If a program is offered on your campus, you may not apply to attend that program on the other campus. However, if you are interested in a program that is offered on another campus, you may apply. If enrolled in the program, you would be provided with transportation to and from the other campus via shuttle bus.

The Gilchrist County School District will admit students to programs without regard to race, color, religion, gender, age, national or ethnic origin, political beliefs, marital status, handicapping condition if otherwise qualified, social and family background, or native language. Completion of an application does not guarantee admission to a program. Students meeting eligibility criteria will be enrolled in their first choice as space and scheduling permits.
