CONGRATULATIONS TO THE DISTRICT FOR THESE **ACCOMPLISHMENTS**

Ladysmith, like most rural Wisconsin school districts, are struggling financially but we still strive for excellence. Here are just a few of our accomplishments this past year:

- Ladysmith Elementary and Ladysmith Middle were named Wisconsin Title 1 Schools of the Year for Beating the Odds. LES has achieved this award for the past 15 years; LMS for the past five. These are awarded to WI schools with high poverty rates that exceed expectations in Math and Reading.
- Two seniors, Trent Vollendorf and Sage Olson, were recognized for their accomplishments as Kohl Scholarship award winners and each received scholarships worth \$10,000.
- Ladysmith Elementary moved from 624 E 6th Street S to 115 E 6th St S. (Former HS and MS). The district is actively working with interested parties to sell the old elementary school and the move has been very positive for students and staff.
