"Congratulations to our Salem High School Art Students, who won first place in the Alpha Rho Tau District Art Show in Houston. Eight schools participated in all, with Salem taking first place with 306 points. Overall, 47 Salem High School students won ribbons. Ribbons were awarded for first through fourth place, honorable mention, and student choice in 64 categories! Salem took home 17 first place ribbons, 22 second place ribbons, 21 third place ribbons, 21 fourth place ribbons, 22 honorable mentions, and 16 students choice ribbons for a total of 119 ribbons and two Community Choice awards. Little House Gifts awarded Aurora Melton an award for her charcoal drawing and Elite Lawn Management awarded Olivia Wisdom for her colored pencil drawing. Katherine Jones placed 4th with 27 individual points and Yadira Blanco placed 3rd overall with 29 individual points. Brooke Wilson placed Best of Show in Photography."
