Formative vs. Summative

Formative: Checkpoints used to see how well students are understanding as they go.

Summative: Given at the end of a unit to measure how much a student has learned.

Determines a student's grade.

Reassessment

Must take place within **one week** of the return of the summative assessment. This allows you to identify areas where there may be knowledge gaps or misunderstandings. It is an opportunity to close the gaps and improve understanding of material.





Eligibility

A student is ineligible if: They have an overall score of a 1 for specific standard AND not actively reassessing or they have three missing assignments for one subject.

Honor Roll

Honor roll students receive an overall score of a 3 in all of their classes. High honor roll students receive an overall score of a 4 in a majority of their classes.
