

The board shall review school attendance areas annually and make such changes as warranted.

**District Attendance Areas**

District attendance areas shall be as follows until changed by board action:

Elementary students from all over the district in early elementary grades PreK-1, elementary grades 2-6 and middle school grades 7 and 8 shall attend school at Riley County Grade School in Riley, Kansas. All high school students from all over the district grades 9 through 12 will attend Riley County High School, located between Leonardville and Riley.

The superintendent shall, on or before April 1 of each year, prepare a written report for the board, concerning the changing of school attendance areas for the succeeding school year and the reasons for such recommendations. The board shall consider the recommendations at the first regular meeting following receipt of the report but shall take no action on the report at that meeting. The changes recommended shall be given to the news media for publication in order that the patrons of the district may be made aware of possible attendance area changes and have an opportunity to appear before the board and express their opinions in regard to the recommended boundary changes. The board shall take no action on the recommended changes until after the patrons of the district have had an opportunity to appear before the board in regard to the recommended changes.
