Goal 1: Academic Growth for Every Child.

- All grade level cohorts will be above the national average in the areas of math and reading [As measured by MAP]

Goal 2: Provide a Consistent and Enhanced Curriculum Across Grade Levels

- Maintain alignment of the district curriculum with Illinois Learning Standards.
- Continue to expand the “Dual Language” program.
- Enhance and refine the Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts, and Math (STEAM) curriculum.
- Explore options to enhance the gifted education program.

Goal 3: Increase Parent and Community Involvement and Awareness
