Parking: Parking on-campus is very limited and requires purchasing a parking permit. See the parking map for more information on parking options; campus parking requires a daily parking permit that can be purchased by downloading the PassportParking App.

*Metered parking (pay with coins; pennies not accepted) is available along most of the perimeter of campus and downtown area as well.

Transportation: Julie Crandall, principal, can drive a limited number of students on a first come basis. Parents are welcome to drive their student or licensed students may drive themselves with parent permission.
