I. CALL TO ORDER

II. CONSENT AGENDA

Jennifer Wilson moved the board approve the agenda as presented. Second by David Higgins. Motion passed with four "yes" votes cast.

III. ADMINISTRATIVE REPORTS

A. Approve the 2013-2014 USD 378 Budget as Presented

Superintendent Brad Starnes discussed the USD 378 budget for the 2013-2014 school year. The board has the option of lowering or raising the mill levy. Superintendent Starnes recommended the board keep the mill rate steady, because (1) history has shown reductions lead to increases in following years (2) there are unknowns such as state aid and (3) several line items in the projected budget have increased. Ross Wahl, Jennifer Wilson and David Higgins expressed a desire to keep the capital outlay at 6 mills. David Higgins moved the board accept the Riley County USD 378 2013-2014 budget as presented with six mills in capital outlay. Second by Jennifer Wilson. Motion passed with four "yes" votes cast.
